Perth Home Care Services provides the following programs:

HOME AND COMMUNITY CARE for people who are frail aged; younger people with disability and their carers.

- Crisis respite services with a one hour response time 24 hours a day every day of the year .

COMMUNITY AGED CARE PACKAGES for aged people with complex care needs. Services provided according to individual needs in most areas.

MENTAL HEALTH COMMUNITY SUPPORT for people with a psychiatric disability across most of the metropolitan area.

VETERANS HOME CARE for veterans across the metropolitan area.

NATIONAL RESPITE FOR CARERS for carers requiring respite care in the wheat belt and north metro area.

INDIVIDUAL OPTIONS for people with disability who have Accommodation Support or Intensive Family Support funding.

ACCESSING SERVICES

You can approach us yourself or ask your family, friends or doctor to contact us on your behalf.

The programs funded by the State and Federal Governments have varying eligibility criteria and referral requirements.

We will assist you to work out what help you need. Family members and relevant other people are also included in the planning as requested.

Most services include the recipient paying a fee that contributes to the total cost. This will be discussed with you.

No one is refused a government funded service because of an inability to pay.
